Besides dropping off and picking up your student, we will provide transportation for your student throughout the entirety of this event. High schoolers are not permitted to drive themselves to activities during the day on Saturday.



PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES

Throughout this season, we want to make sure you know all we plan to do as we begin coming alongside your family for The Weekend. Below you will find a list of precautions that will be in place as we commit to being safe, smart, and strategic.

- · Temps checks for students and volunteers before entering
- Similar to Midweek and Sunday programming, we will place your student in a small group of their peers and leaders to travel with throughout The Weekend
- · Social distancing between groups
- \cdot Masks required for volunteers except when on stage
- · Masks recommended for students when distancing isn't possible
- · Clear communication with you in the event of a COVID-19 exposure
- We plan to sanitize surfaces between services/during the event and offer hand sanitizing stations
- · A streamlined check-in process, as contactless as possible
