ABIDE MENTORING

Why mentoring?

We're motivated throughout scripture to mentor:

Instruct older women to train younger women (Titus 2:1, 3-5) Motivate each other, meet together and encourage one another. (Hebrews 10:24-25)

Applications are open to ladies 18-45 who consider Sevier Heights/The Walk their home church and are involved in a Community Group. Prepare for a one year commitment of meeting one-on-one with a mentor and completing the curriculum.

Who should apply?

It's simply a practical way to walk toward Jesus together. A mentor can offer wisdom and advice from her relationship with Jesus and life experience. Sometimes you need someone a few steps ahead of you to help you take your next step.

What's next after I apply?

We'll prayerfully work through the applications and select a group of applicants to move forward with interviews. Our goal is to match each mentee with a hand-selected mentor based on personality, stage of life and schedule to foster intentional relationships. If you are not selected for an interview, we encourage you to plug into a Community Group at Sevier Heights and/or an area of service. There are so many incredible women in our church who want to encourage you to take your next steps with Jesus.

What is the curriculum?

All mentors will walk mentees through Flourish: A Mentoring Journey from Passion City Church.

How long is it?

It's a one-year commitment from August 2021 to August 2022. You will meet with your mentor once a week or once every other week for about an hour.

What are expectations for mentees?

Attend Sevier Heights/The Walk services, be involved in a Community Group, spend time with Jesus each week with the Flourish curriculum, meet with your mentor as scheduled, commit to being real and intentional in your mentoring relationship and maintain these commitments for the full year.

How can I be a mentor?

We are working on a list of hand-selected mentors for the upcoming year. Mentors must be an official partner of Sevier Heights, serving within the church, in a community group and participating in regular giving.
