What is Summer Smash?

KidHeights is hosting Summer Smash, a customizable day camp experience, on June 8-11! Our goal is to create a remarkable environment for completed Kindergarten through 5th graders to help them make lasting memories while learning more about Jesus.



What does a day at Summer Smash look like?

Summer Smash will take place on June 8th through the 11th. This event will be from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Monday through Thursday. Here is a brief overview of what your child will experience while here:

Here is some additional information on some of the events throughout the day:

CHECK-IN

To check your child in, all you need to do is park in the front lot and follow signage to your child's grade tent to check in and receive their lanyard. Then, a volunteer will direct you to your child's age-appropriate drop-off zone.

GROUPS

Our Groups rotation is designed to help kids learn more about Jesus. The large group experience includes teaching and is followed by time in age-appropriate small groups. Small groups allow kids to connect, ask questions, and dig a little deeper into what they just heard.

CHECK-OUT

To check your child out at the end of the day, just park in the front lot, follow the signage to your child's grade area, and show your child's security tag to their leader.

TRACK GUIDE

Here is an overview of the 2026 Summer Smash Track Options! Remember, while registering you will have the opportunity to rank your child's top four tracks, and we'll select two from that list for them to jump in on for the week.

(Please note, Kindergarten kids will be limited to 6 options)



TAKE-OFF

This indoor track is for Kindergarten only and is centered around fun games and activities designed specifically for them!



MAKE IT!

Kids will lean into their creative and engineering side to create and build a variety of fun crafts and interesting projects!



OUTDOOR GAMES

Kids will play outside in some organized team games such as kickball, wiffle ball, and frisbee!



CHEERNASTICS

We'll combine cheer and gymnastics into one fun time!



FLAG FOOTBALL

Kids will learn some basic skills such as passing, catching, and agility while taking part in scrimmaging against one another!



BASKETBALL

Kids will learn some basic skills such as dribbling, passing, and shooting while playing various versions of their favorite game!



SOCCER

Kids will practice all the skills they need to compete in a match including controlling, passing, and shooting the ball!



MUSIC

Kids will get to practice their worship and rhythm skills in fun and exciting ways!



CRAZY CREATIONS

From wacky science experiments to weird and delicious snack creations, this track has it all!



ARCHERY

Kids will learn basic archery skills in a safe and supervised environment! (3rd-5th grade only)
